Luke 18:35-43 ³⁵ As Jesus was approaching Jericho, a blind man was sitting by the road begging. ³⁶ Now hearing a crowd going by, he *began* to inquire what this was. ³⁷ They told him that Jesus of Nazareth was passing by. ³⁸ And he called out, saying, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" ³⁹ Those who led the way were sternly telling him to be quiet; but he kept crying out all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" ⁴⁰ And Jesus stopped and commanded that he be brought to Him; and when he came near, He questioned him, ⁴¹ "What do you want Me to do for you?" And he said, "Lord, *I want* recovery of my sight!" ⁴² And Jesus said to him, "Recover your sight; your faith has saved you." ⁴³ Immediately he recovered his sight and *began* following Him, glorifying God; and when all the people saw it, they gave praise to God.

Luke 19:1-10 He entered Jericho and was passing through. ² And there was a man called by the name of Zaccheus; he was a ruler of the tax collectors and he was rich. ³ Zaccheus was trying to see who Jesus was, and was unable because of the crowd, for he was small in stature. ⁴ So he ran on ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree in order to see Him, for He was about to pass through that way. ⁵ When Jesus came to the place, He looked up and said to him, "Zaccheus, hurry and come down, for today I must/it is necessary that I stay at your house." ⁶ And he hurried and came down and welcomed Him [as a guest for a feast] gladly. ⁷ When they saw it, they all *began* to grumble, saying, "He has gone to be the guest [at a feast] of a man who is a sinner." ⁸ Zaccheus stopped and said to the Lord, "Behold, Lord, half of my possessions I will give to the poor, and if I have defrauded anyone of anything, I will give back four times as much." ⁹ And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because he, too, is a son of Abraham. ¹⁰ For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."
