The New Testament author tells us that the Holy Spirit is speaking:

The Old Testament author tells us that Yahweh is speaking:

Psa. 95:6-11 ⁶Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before Yahweh, our Maker! ⁷ For he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand. Today, if you hear his voice, 8 do not harden your hearts, as at Meribah, as on the day at Massah in the wilderness, when your fathers put me to the test and put me to the proof, though they had seen my work. 10 For forty years I/Yahweh loathed that generation and said, "They are a people who go astray in their heart, and they have not known my ways."11 Therefore I swore in my wrath, "They shall not enter my rest."

Devil: I will give You all this domain and its glory; for it has been handed over to me, and I give it to whomever I wish. Therefore if you worship before me, it shall all be Yours.

Jesus: It is written, "You shall worship the Lord your God and serve Him only."

Narrator: And he led Him to Jerusalem and had Him stand on the pinnacle of the temple.

Devil: If you are the Son of God, throw Yourself down from here; for it is written, "He will command His angels concerning You to guard You," and "On their hands they will bear You up, so that You will not strike Your foot against a stone."

Jesus: It is said, "You shall not tempt the Lord your God."

Narrator: When the devil had finished every temptation, he left Him until an opportune time. And Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit and news about Him spread through all the surrounding district.
