Phil. 2:9-11

Therefore also God has highly exalted Him and to him he has bestowed the Name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow in heaven and on earth and in the depths and every tongue confess that the Lord (kurios) is Jesus Christ to the glory of God the Father.

Isaiah 45:22-23

Turn to Me and be saved, all the ends of the earth; For I am God, and there is no other. I have sworn by Myself, the word has gone forth from My mouth in righteousness and will not turn back, that to Me every knee will bow, every tongue will confess (in Septuagint)...

Isaiah 41:13

“For I am the LORD/ YAHWEH/KURIOS your God, who upholds your right hand, Who says to you, ‘Do not fear, I will help you.’

Isaiah 42:6

“I am the LORD/YAHWEH/KURIOS, I have called You in righteousness...

Isaiah 42:8

“I am the LORD/ YAHWEH/KURIOS, that is My name; I will not give My glory to another, Nor My praise to graven images.

Isaiah 43:3

“For I am the LORD/ YAHWEH/KURIOS your God, The Holy One of Israel, your Savior...

1 Corinthians 12:3

Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God says, “Jesus is accursed”; and no one can say, “Jesus is Lord/Kurios,” except by the Holy Spirit.

Romans 10:9

That if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord/Kurios, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

## Luke 1-2 and Lord/Kurios

### Luke 1:6

They were both righteous in the sight of God, walking blamelessly in all the commandments and requirements of the **Lord/Kurios**.

### Luke 1:9

according to the custom of the priestly office, he was chosen by lot to enter the temple of the **Lord/Kurios** and burn incense.

### Luke 1:11

And an angel of the **Lord/Kurios** appeared to him, standing to the right of the altar of incense.

### Luke 1:15

For he will be great in the sight of the **Lord/Kurios**; and he will drink no wine or liquor, and he will be filled with the Holy Spirit while yet in his mother's womb.

### Luke 1:16

And he will turn many of the sons of Israel back to the **Lord/Kurios** their God.

### Luke 1:17

It is he who will go as a *forerunner* before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah...so as to make ready a people prepared for the **Lord/Kurios**."

### Luke 1:25

"This is the way the **Lord/Kurios** has dealt with me in the days when He looked *with favor* upon *me*, to take away my disgrace among men."

### Luke 1:28

He said to her, "Greetings, favored one! The **Lord/Kurios** is with you."

### Luke 1:32

He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the **Lord/Kurios** God will give Him the throne of His father David;

### Luke 1:38

And Mary said, "Behold, the bondservant of the **Lord/Kurios**; may it be done to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her.

### Luke 1:43

[Elizabeth says to Mary when Mary arrives]: And how has it *happened* to me, that the mother of my **Lord/Kurios** would come to me?

### Luke 1:45

And blessed *is* she who believed that there would be a fulfillment of what had been spoken to her by the **Lord/Kurios**."

### Luke 1:46

[ *The Magnificat* ] And Mary said: "My soul exalts the **Lord/Kurios**,

**Luke 1:58**

Elizabeth's neighbors and her relatives heard that the **Lord/Kurios** had displayed His great mercy toward her; and they were rejoicing with her.

**Luke 1:66**

All who heard the shepherds kept them in mind, saying, "What then will this child *turn out to be*?" For the hand of the **Lord/Kurios** was certainly with him.

**Luke 1:68**

Zaccharias said, "Blessed be the **Lord** God of Israel, For He has visited us and accomplished redemption for His people,

**Luke 1:76**

Zaccharias said to his infant son John, "And you, child, will be called the prophet of the Most High; For you will go on BEFORE THE **LORD/KURIOS** TO PREPARE HIS WAYS;

**Luke 2:9**

And an angel of the **Lord/Kurios** suddenly stood before the shepherds, and the glory of the **Lord/Kurios** shone around them; and they were terribly frightened.

**Luke 2:11**

[An angel said to the shepherds]: for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior, who is Christ the **Lord/Kurios**.

**Luke 2:15**

When the angels had gone away from them into heaven, the shepherds *began* saying to one another, "Let us go straight to Bethlehem then, and see this thing that has happened which the **Lord/Kurios** has made known to us."

**Luke 2:22**

And when the days for their purification according to the law of Moses were completed, they brought Him up to Jerusalem to present Him to the **Lord/Kurios**

**Luke 2:23**

(as it is written in the Law of the **Lord/Kurios**, "EVERY *firstborn* MALE THAT OPENS THE WOMB SHALL BE CALLED HOLY TO THE **LORD/KURIOS**"),

**Luke 2:24,**

and to offer a sacrifice according to what was said in the Law of the **Lord/Kurios**, "A PAIR OF TURTLEDOVES OR TWO YOUNG PIGEONS."

And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the **Lord's/Kurios** Christ.

**Luke 2:29**

"Now **Lord/Kurios**, You are releasing Your bond-servant to depart in peace, According to Your word...

#### Luke 5:4-11

<sup>4</sup> When He had finished speaking, He said to Simon, "Put out into the deep water and let down your nets for a catch."<sup>5</sup> Simon answered and said, "Master, we worked hard all night and caught nothing, but I will do as You say *and* let down the nets."<sup>6</sup> When they had done this, they enclosed a great quantity of fish, and their nets *began* to break; <sup>7</sup> so they signaled to their partners in the other boat for them to come and help them. And they came and filled both of the boats, so that they began to sink. <sup>8</sup> But when Simon Peter saw *that*, he fell down at Jesus' feet, saying, "Go away from me Lord/kurios, for I am a sinful man!" <sup>9</sup> For amazement had seized him and all his companions because of the catch of fish which they had taken; <sup>10</sup> and so also *were* James and John, sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not fear, from now on you will be catching men."<sup>11</sup> When they had brought their boats to land, they left everything and followed Him.

#### Luke 8:22-25

<sup>22</sup> Now on one of *those* days Jesus and His disciples got into a boat, and He said to them, "Let us go over to the other side of the lake." So they launched out. <sup>23</sup> But as they were sailing along He fell asleep; and a fierce gale of wind descended on the lake, and they *began* to be swamped and to be in danger. <sup>24</sup> They came to Jesus and woke Him up, saying, "Master, Master, we are perishing!" And He got up and rebuked the wind and the surging waves, and they stopped, and it became calm. <sup>25</sup> And He said to them, "Where is your faith?" They were fearful and amazed, saying to one another, "Who then is this, that He commands even the winds and the water, and they obey Him?"

#### Luke 8:45-48

<sup>43</sup> And a woman who had a hemorrhage for twelve years, and could not be healed by anyone, <sup>44</sup> came up behind Him and touched the fringe of His cloak, and immediately her hemorrhage stopped. <sup>45</sup> And Jesus said, "Who is the one who touched Me?" And while they were all denying it, Peter said, "Master, the people are crowding and pressing in on You." <sup>46</sup> But Jesus said, "Someone did touch Me, for I was aware that power had gone out of Me." <sup>47</sup> When the woman saw that she had not escaped notice, she came trembling and fell down before Him, and declared in the presence of all the people the reason why she had touched Him, and how she had been immediately healed. <sup>48</sup> And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well/saved you; go in peace."

Luke 9:28-36

<sup>28</sup> Some eight days after these sayings, He took along Peter and John and James, and went up on the mountain to pray. <sup>29</sup> And while He was praying, the appearance of His face became different, and His clothing *became* white *and* lightening flashes. <sup>30</sup> And look! Two men were talking with Him; and they were Moses and Elijah, <sup>31</sup> who, appearing in glory, were speaking of His exodus which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem. <sup>32</sup> Now Peter and his companions had been overcome with sleep; but when they were fully awake, they saw His glory and the two men standing with Him. <sup>33</sup> And as these were leaving Him, Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good for us to be here; let us make

three tabernacles:

one for You, and one for Moses, and one for Elijah"—not realizing what he was saying. <sup>34</sup> As he was saying these things, a cloud came and overshadowed them, and they were afraid as they entered the cloud. <sup>35</sup> And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is my Son, my Chosen One; listen to him!" <sup>36</sup> And when the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone. And they kept silent and told no one in those days anything of what they had seen.

Luke 9:43b-50

Jesus said to His disciples, <sup>44</sup> "Let these words sink into your ears; for the Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men." <sup>45</sup> But they did not understand this statement... <sup>46</sup> An argument started among them as to which of them might be the greatest. <sup>47</sup> But Jesus, knowing what they were thinking in their heart, took a child and stood him by His side, <sup>48</sup> and said, "Whoever receives this child in My name receives Me, and whoever receives Me receives Him who sent Me; for the one who is least among all of you, this is the one who is great." <sup>49</sup> John answered and said, "Master, we saw someone casting out demons in Your name; and we tried to prevent him because he does not follow along with us." <sup>50</sup> But Jesus said, "Do not hinder *him*; for he who is not against you is for you."
