A. ¹² Many **bulls** have surrounded me;
Strong *bulls* of Bashan have encircled me.

¹³ They open wide their mouth at me,

B. As a ravening and a roaring **lion**.

¹⁴ I am poured out like water,
And all my bones are out of joint;
My heart is like wax;
It is melted within me.

¹⁵ My strength is dried up like a potsherd,
And my tongue cleaves to my jaws;
And You lay me in the dust of death.

C. ¹⁶ For **dogs** have surrounded me;
A band of evildoers has encompassed me;

X. They pierced my hands and my feet.

¹⁷ **I can count all my bones.**

They look, they stare at me;

¹⁸ **They divide my garments among them,**

And for my clothing they cast lots.

¹⁹ But You, O LORD, be not far off;

C. My only *life* from the power of the **dog**.

B. ²¹ Save me from the **lion's** mouth;

A. From the horns of the **wild oxen** (synonym for bull) You answer me.

[Gabriel said to Mary],
And behold, you will
conceive in your womb
and bear a son, and
you shall name Him
Jesus. He will be great
and will be called the
Son of the Most High...

Luke 2:49

[in the Temple]. Jesus
said to His parents,
“Why is it that you
were looking for Me?
Did you not know that
I had to be in My
Father’s house?”

Luke 3:21-22

Jesus was also
baptized, and while He
was praying, heaven
was opened, and the
Holy Spirit descended
upon Him... like a dove,
and a voice came out of
heaven, “You are My
beloved Son, in You I
am well-pleased.”

Luke 4:1-3

Jesus, full of the Holy
Spirit, ...was led by the
Spirit in the wilderness
for forty days, being
tempted by the devil.
...He became hungry.
And the devil said, “If

MESSIANIC PROPHECIES ABOUT THE SON OF GOD

PSALM 2

Why are the nations in an uproar
And the peoples devising a vain thing?
The kings of the earth take their stand
And the rulers take counsel together
Against the LORD and against His Anointed/Messiah, saying,
Let us tear their fetters apart
And cast away their cords from us!"
He who sits in the heavens laughs,
The Lord scoffs at them.

I will surely tell of the decree of the LORD: He said to Me, 'You are My Son,

2 Samuel 7:11-14

[Nathan to David], The LORD also declares to you that the LORD will make a house for you. When your days are complete and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your seed after you, who come forth from you, and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build a house for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. I will be a father to him and he will be a son to Me..."

1 Chronicles 17:10-14

[Nathan to David], Moreover, I tell you that the LORD will build a house for you. When your days are fulfilled that you must go to be with your fathers, that I will set up one of your seed after you, who will be of your sons; and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build for Me a house, and I will establish his throne forever. I will be his father and he shall be My son; and I will not take My lovingkindness away from him...

Psalm 89

[The psalmist remembers the promise given to David and, speaking of David's seed, the Messiah, Yahweh says],
He will cry to Me, 'You are my Father
My God, and the rock of my salvation.'
I also shall make him My firstborn,
The highest of the kings of the earth.
My lovingkindness I will keep for him forever.

MARK 9:2-8

²...Jesus took with Him Peter and James and John, and brought them up on a high mountain by themselves. And He was transfigured before them; ³and His garments became radiant and exceedingly white, as no launderer on earth can whiten them. ⁴Elijah appeared to them along with Moses; and they were talking with Jesus. ⁵Peter said to Jesus, "Rabbi, it is good for us to be here; let us make three tabernacles, one for You, and one for Moses, and one for Elijah."
⁶For he did not know what to answer; for they became terrified. ⁷Then a cloud formed, overshadowing them and a voice came out of the cloud, "This is My beloved Son, hear Him!" ⁸All at once they looked around and saw no one with them anymore, except Jesus alone.

LUKE 9:28-36

²⁸...after these sayings, He took along Peter and John and James, and went up on the mountain to pray. ²⁹And while He was praying, the appearance of His face became different, and His clothing became white and gleaming. ³⁰And behold, two men were talking with Him; and they were Moses and Elijah, ³¹who, appearing in glory, were speaking of His exodus which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem. ³²Now Peter and his companions had been overcome with sleep; but when they were fully awake, they saw His glory and the two men standing with Him. ³³And as these were leaving Him, Peter said to Jesus "Master, it is good for us to be here; let us make three tabernacles: one for You, and one for Moses, and one for Elijah"—not realizing what he was saying. ³⁴While he was saying this, a cloud formed and began to overshadow them; and they were afraid as they entered the cloud. ³⁵Then a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My Son, My Chosen One; hear Him!" ³⁶And when the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone. And they kept silent, and reported to no one in those days any of the things which they had seen.

TRANSFIGURATION OF JESUS

EXODUS 24

(After being in the wilderness, and after the Israelites agreed to keep the commandments)

1 Then Yahweh said to Moses, "come up to Yahweh [on Mt. Sinai], you and Aaron, Nadab and Abihu...

⁹ then Moses went up [Mt. Sinai] with Aaron, Nadab and Abihu...

¹² Now Yahweh said to Moses, "come up to me on the mountain and remain there, and I will give you the stone tablets with the law and the commandment which I have written for their instruction." So Moses arose with Joshua his servant, and Moses went up to the mountain of god. ¹⁵ Then Moses went up to the mountain, and the cloud covered the mountain. ¹⁶ And the glory of Yahweh rested on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it for six days; and on the seventh day he called to Moses from the midst of the cloud. ¹⁸ And Moses entered the midst of the cloud as he went up to the mountain; and Moses was on the mountain...

Exodus 33-34

(When Moses asked to see God's glory)

¹⁸ Then Moses said to Yahweh, "I pray Thee, show me Thy glory!" ...²¹ Then Yahweh said, "Behold, there is a place by me, and you shall stand there on the rock; ²² ...while My glory is passing by, I will put you in the cleft of the rock and cover you with my hand until I have passed by.

²³ Then I will take My hand away and you shall see My back, but My face shall not be seen." ^{34:4} Moses ...went up to Mount Sinai, as Yahweh had commanded him...

⁵ And Yahweh descended in the cloud and stood there with Moses as he called upon the name of Yahweh.

⁶ Then Yahweh passed by in front of him and proclaimed, Yahweh, Yahweh Elohim, compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in lovingkindness and truth...²⁹ And it came about when Moses was coming down from Mount Sinai, that Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone ...³⁰ When the sons of Israel saw Moses, his skin shone and they were afraid to come near him.

1 Kings 19

(After running from Jezebel through the wilderness for 40 days)

⁸ Then Elijah came to Horeb (Sinai), the mountain of God. ⁹ then he came there to a cave, and lodged there; and behold, the word of Yahweh came to him, and he said to him, "What are you doing here, Elijah?"

¹⁰ And he said, "I have been very zealous for Yahweh; for the sons of Israel have forsaken your covenant...and I alone am left; and they seek my life, to take it away." ¹¹ so He said, "Go forth and stand on the mountain before Yahweh." And Yahweh was passing by! And a great strong wind was rending the mountains and breaking in pieces the rocks before Yahweh; but Yahweh was not in the wind. And after the wind an earthquake, but Yahweh was not in the earthquake. ¹² And after the earthquake a fire, but Yahweh was not in the fire; and after the fire a sound of gentle blowing.

¹³ And it came about when Elijah heard it, that he wrapped his face in his mantle, and went out and stood in the entrance of the cave. And behold, a voice came to him and said, "What are you doing here, Elijah?"

¹⁴ Then Elijah said, "I have been very zealous for Yahweh, for the Sons of Israel have forsaken your covenant... and I alone am left. And they seek my life, to take it away."
