LUKE

11/17/16

1 Peter 2:21-25

<sup>21</sup> For you have been called for this purpose, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example for you to follow in His steps, <sup>22</sup> WHO COMMITTED NO SIN, NOR WAS ANY DECEIT FOUND IN HIS MOUTH; <sup>23</sup> and while being reviled, He did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting *Himself* to Him who judges righteously; <sup>24</sup> and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed. <sup>25</sup> For you were continually straying like sheep, but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Guardian of your souls.

Isaiah 53:4-11

<sup>4</sup> Surely our griefs He Himself bore,  
And our sorrows He carried;  
Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken,  
Smitten of God, and afflicted.  
<sup>5</sup> But He was pierced through for our transgressions,  
He was crushed for our iniquities;  
The chastening for our well-being *fell* upon Him,  
And by His scourging we are healed.  
<sup>6</sup> All of us like sheep have gone astray,  
Each of us has turned to his own way;  
But the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all  
To fall on Him.  
<sup>7</sup> He was oppressed and He was afflicted,  
Yet He did not open His mouth;  
Like a lamb that is led to slaughter,  
And like a sheep that is silent before its shearers,  
So He did not open His mouth.  
...<sup>9</sup> His grave was assigned with wicked men,  
Yet He was with a rich man in His death,  
Because He had done no violence,  
Nor was there any deceit in His mouth.  
...<sup>11</sup> As a result of the anguish of His soul,  
He will see *it and* be satisfied;  
By His knowledge the Righteous One,  
My Servant, will justify the many,  
As He will bear their iniquities.

**Luke 21:25-28**

<sup>25</sup> "There will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and on the earth dismay among nations, in perplexity at the roaring of the sea and the waves, <sup>26</sup> men fainting from fear and the expectation of the things which are coming upon the world; for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. <sup>27</sup> Then they will see THE SON OF MAN COMING IN A CLOUD with power and great glory. <sup>28</sup> But when these things begin to take place, straighten up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near."

**How does Luke prepare us for the above passage?**

Luke 9 <sup>26</sup> For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when He comes in His glory, and *the glory* of the Father and of the holy angels.

Luke 12 <sup>39</sup> "But be sure of this, that if the head of the house had known at what hour the thief was coming, he would not have allowed his house to be broken into. <sup>40</sup> You too, be ready; for the Son of Man is coming at an hour that you do not expect."

Luke 17 <sup>22</sup> And He said to the disciples, "The days will come when you will long to see one of the days of the Son of Man, and you will not see it. <sup>23</sup> They will say to you, 'Look there! Look here!' Do not go away, and do not run after *them*. <sup>24</sup> For just like the lightning, when it flashes out of one part of the sky, shines to the other part of the sky, so will the Son of Man be in His day. <sup>25</sup> But first He must suffer many things and be rejected by this generation. . <sup>26</sup> And just as it happened in the days of Noah, so it will be also in the days of the Son of Man: <sup>27</sup> they were eating, they were drinking, they were marrying, they were being given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and the flood came and destroyed them all. <sup>28</sup> It was the same as happened in the days of Lot: they were eating, they were drinking, they were buying, they were selling, they were planting, they were building; <sup>29</sup> but on the day that Lot went out from Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven and destroyed them all. <sup>30</sup> It will be just the same on the day that the Son of Man is revealed.

Luke 18 <sup>8</sup> I tell you that He will bring about justice for them quickly. However, when the Son of Man comes, will He find faith on the earth?"

Luke 21:25-28 and signs in the heavens

<sup>25</sup> “There will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and on the earth dismay among nations, in perplexity at the roaring of the sea and the waves, <sup>26</sup> men fainting from fear and the expectation of the things which are coming upon the world; for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. <sup>27</sup> Then they will see THE SON OF MAN COMING IN A CLOUD with power and great glory. <sup>28</sup> But when these things begin to take place, straighten up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near.”

### **What does this Genesis passage have to do with end time events?**

Genesis 1:14-19

<sup>14</sup> Then God said, “Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night, and let them be for signs and for seasons and for days and years; <sup>15</sup> and let them be for lights in the expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth”; and it was so. <sup>16</sup> God made the two great lights, the greater light to govern the day, and the lesser light to govern the night; *He made* the stars also. <sup>17</sup> God placed them in the expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth, <sup>18</sup> and to govern the day and the night, and to separate the light from the darkness; and God saw that it was good.

### **Daniel 7**

<sup>13</sup> “I saw in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven there came one like a son of man, and he came to the Ancient of Days and was presented before him. <sup>14</sup> And to him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him; his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom one that shall not be destroyed.

### **Isaiah 13:10, 13**

<sup>10</sup> For the stars of the heavens and their constellations will not give their light; the sun will be dark at its rising, and the moon will not shed its light. <sup>13</sup> Therefore I will make the heavens tremble, and the earth will be shaken out of its place, at the wrath of the LORD of hosts in the day of his fierce anger.

### **Isaiah 30:30**

<sup>30</sup> And the LORD will cause his majestic voice to be heard and the descending blow of his arm to be seen, in furious anger and a flame of devouring fire, with a cloudburst and storm and hailstones.

### **Ezekiel 32:7-8**

<sup>7</sup> When I blot you out, I will cover the heavens and make their stars dark; I will cover the sun with a cloud, and the moon shall not give its light. <sup>8</sup> All the bright lights of heaven will I make dark over you, and put darkness on your land, declares the Lord GOD.

**Ezekiel 38:22**

<sup>22</sup> With pestilence and bloodshed I will enter into judgment with him, and I will rain upon him and his hordes and the many peoples who are with him torrential rains and hailstones, fire and sulfur.

**Joel 2**

Blow a trumpet in Zion;  
    sound an alarm on my holy mountain!  
Let all the inhabitants of the land tremble,  
    for the day of the LORD is coming;  
it is near,  
<sup>2</sup> a day of darkness and gloom,  
    a day of clouds and thick darkness!  
Like blackness there is spread upon the mountains...

<sup>10</sup> The earth quakes before them;  
    the heavens tremble.  
The sun and the moon are darkened,  
    and the stars withdraw their shining.  
...For the day of the LORD is great and very awesome;  
    who can endure it?

...<sup>30</sup> "And I will show wonders in the heavens and on the earth, blood and fire and columns of smoke. <sup>31</sup> The sun shall be turned to darkness, and the moon to blood, before the great and awesome day of the LORD comes. <sup>32</sup> And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be those who escape, as the LORD has said, and among the survivors shall be those whom the LORD calls.

**Amos 5:18-20**

<sup>18</sup> Alas, you who are longing for the day of the LORD,  
For what purpose *will* the day of the LORD *be* to you?  
It *will be* darkness and not light;  
<sup>19</sup> As when a man flees from a lion  
And a bear meets him,  
Or goes home, leans his hand against the wall  
And a snake bites him.  
<sup>20</sup> *Will* not the day of the LORD *be* darkness instead of light,  
Even gloom with no brightness in it?

**From past experience, figure out what I will have you do with all these passages and do it :~)**

Luke 18:1-8

And he told them a parable to the effect that they ought always to pray and not lose heart. <sup>2</sup> He said, "In a certain city there was a judge who neither feared God nor respected man. <sup>3</sup> And there was a widow in that city who kept coming to him and saying, 'Give me justice against my adversary.' <sup>4</sup> For a while he refused, but afterward he said to himself, 'Though I neither fear God nor respect man, <sup>5</sup> yet because this widow keeps bothering me, I will give her justice, so that she will not beat me down by her continual coming.'"<sup>6</sup> And the Lord said, "Hear what the unrighteous judge says. <sup>7</sup> And will not God give justice to his elect, who cry to him day and night? Will he delay long over them? <sup>8</sup> I tell you, he will give justice to them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?"

Luke 21:29-36

<sup>29</sup> Then He told them a parable: "Behold the fig tree and all the trees; <sup>30</sup> as soon as they put forth *leaves*, you see it and know for yourselves that summer is now near. <sup>31</sup> So you also, when you see these things happening, recognize that the kingdom of God is near. <sup>32</sup> Truly I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all things take place. <sup>33</sup> Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will not pass away. <sup>34</sup> "Be on guard, so that your hearts will not be weighted down with dissipation and drunkenness and the worries of life, and that day will not come on you suddenly like a trap; <sup>35</sup> for it will come upon all those who dwell on the face of all the earth. <sup>36</sup> But keep on the alert at all times, praying that you may have strength to escape all these things that are about to take place, and to stand before the Son of Man."  
**What does dissipation mean?**

### Luke 21:34-36

"Be on guard, so that your hearts will not be weighted down with dissipation and drunkenness and the worries of life, and **that day** will not come on you suddenly like a trap; <sup>35</sup> for it will come upon all those who dwell on the face of all the earth. <sup>36</sup> But keep on the alert at all times, praying that you may have strength to escape all these things that are about to take place, and to stand before the Son of Man."

### Romans 12:12

<sup>12</sup> Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer.

### Ephesians 6:18

<sup>18</sup> praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints...

### 1 Thessalonians 1:2

<sup>2</sup> We give thanks to God always for all of you, constantly mentioning you in our prayers...

### 1 Thessalonians 5:17

<sup>17</sup> pray without ceasing...

### 1 Peter 4:7

<sup>7</sup> The end of all things is at hand; therefore be self-controlled and sober-minded for the sake of your prayers.
