Who sanctifies?

Yahweh

Exodus 31:13 Yahweh says, "But as for you, speak to the sons of Israel, saying, 'You shall surely observe My Sabbaths; for this is a sign between Me and you throughout your generations, that you may know that I am **Yahweh who sanctifies you.**"

Ezekiel 20:12 Also I gave them My Sabbaths to be a sign between Me and them, that they might know that **I am Yahweh who sanctifies them.**

John 17:17 Jesus prays to **the Father**, "**Sanctify them in the truth**; Your word is truth."

Thessalonians 5:23
Now may the **God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely.**

Jesus

Hebrews 13:12
Therefore **Jesus** also, that he might **sanctify the people** through His own blood, suffered outside the gate.

Ephesians 5:25-26
Husbands, love your wives, just as **Christ** also loved the church and gave himself up for her, so that **he might sanctify her**, having cleansed her. . .

Holy Spirit

1 Peter 1:1-2
Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to those who reside as aliens, who are chosen according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, by the **sanctifying work of the Spirit...**

Romans 15:16
...the Gentiles may become acceptable, **sanctified by the Holy Spirit.**

2 Thessalonians 2:13
But we should always give thanks to God for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God has chosen you from the beginning for salvation through **sanctification by the Spirit** and faith in the truth.

Who was pierced?

Zechariah 12:9-10 Yahweh says, "And in that day I will set about to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem. I will pour out on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the Spirit of grace and of supplication, so that **they will look on Me whom they have pierced; and they will mourn for Him**, as one mourns for an only son, and they will weep bitterly over Him like the bitter weeping over a firstborn.

Revelation 1:7 [John says of Jesus], "Behold, He is coming with the clouds and **every eye will see Him, even those who pierced him; and all the tribes of the earth will mourn over Him.**"

Whose blood purchased/redeemed us?

Acts 20:28 Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church **of God which He purchased with His own blood.**

Revelation 5:9 They sang a new song [to the Lamb], saying, "Worthy are You to take the book and to break its seals for you were slain, and **purchased for God with Your blood** men from every tribe and tongue and people and nation."

GOD

Genesis 1:1

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Isaiah 43:7

[The LORD says], "everyone who is called by my name, and whom I have created for my glory whom I have formed, even whom I have made."

Isaiah 40:28

Do you not know? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the Lord, the creator of the ends of the earth does not become weary or tired.

Jesus, the Son

What is said of God is said of Jesus.

John 3:3

All things came into being through Jesus, and apart from him nothing came into being that has come into being.

Colossians 1:16

For by Jesus all things were created, both in the heavens and on the earth...all things have been created through him and for him.

Hebrews 1:8, 10

To the son the Lord says, "you, Lord, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth and the heavens are the works of your hands. (The Lord God calls his son, "Lord" and says that his son laid the foundation of the earth and the heavens.)

John 1:10

Jesus was in the world, and the world was made through him, and the world did not know him.

Now the Feast of Unleavened Bread, which is called the Passover, was approaching. ²The chief priests and the scribes were seeking how they might put Him to death; for they were afraid of the people.

³And Satan entered into Judas who was called Iscariot, belonging to the number of the twelve. ⁴And he went away and discussed with the chief priests and officers how he might betray Him to them. ⁵They were glad and agreed to give him money. ⁶So he consented, and *began* seeking a good opportunity to betray Him to them apart from the crowd.

Up to Chapter 22, Judas is not mentioned outside the list of Apostles. This is about to change:

Vs. 3 And Satan entered into Judas who was called Iscariot, belonging to the number of the twelve.

Vs. 21 But behold, the hand of the one betraying Me is with Mine on the table. ²² For indeed, the Son of Man is going as it has been determined; but woe to that man by whom He is betrayed!"

Vss. 47-48 While He was still speaking, behold, a crowd *came*, and the one called Judas, one of the twelve, was preceding them; and he approached Jesus to kiss Him. ⁴⁸ But Jesus said to him, "Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?"

Who is responsible?

Luke 9 ⁴⁴ "Let these words sink into your ears; for the Son of Man is going to be delivered/handed over/betrayed/ paradidomi into the hands of men."

Luke 18 ³¹ Then He took the twelve aside and said to them, "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and all things which are written through the prophets about the Son of Man will be accomplished.³² For He will be handed over/delivered/ betrayed/ paradidomi to the Gentiles, and will be mocked and mistreated and spit upon,³³ and after they have scourged Him, they will kill Him; and the third day He will rise again."

Luke 22 ²¹ But behold, the hand of the one betraying Me/handing over/delivering/ paradidomi is with Mine on the table.²² For indeed, the Son of Man is going as it has been determined; but woe to that man by whom He is betrayed/handed over/delivered/ paradidomi!"

Luke 22 ⁴⁷ While He was still speaking, behold, a crowd *came*, and the one called Judas, one of the twelve, was preceding them; and he approached Jesus to kiss Him.⁴⁸ But Jesus said to him, "Judas, are you betraying/handing over/delivering/ paradidomi the Son of Man with a kiss?"

Luke 23 ²⁴ And Pilate pronounced sentence that their demand be granted.²⁵ And he released the man they were asking for who had been thrown into prison for insurrection and murder, but he delivered/handed over/betrayed/ paradidomi Jesus to their will.

Luke 24 ¹⁸ One of *them*, named Cleopas, answered and said to Him, "Are You the only one visiting Jerusalem and unaware of the things which have happened here in these days?"¹⁹ And He said to them, "What things?" And they said to Him, "The things about Jesus the Nazarene, who was a prophet mighty in

deed and word in the sight of God and all the people,²⁰ and how the chief priests and our rulers delivered/handed over/betrayed/ paradidomi Him to the sentence of death, and crucified Him.

Peter's sermon to bystanders on the day of Pentecost:

Acts 2 ²² "Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a man attested to you by God with mighty works and wonders and signs that God did through him in your midst, as you yourselves know—²³ this Jesus, delivered up/handed over/betrayed/ paradidomi according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men.²⁴ God raised him up, loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him to be held by it.

Luke 22:7-13
NARRATOR: Then came the day of Unleavened Bread on which the Passover *lamb* had to be sacrificed. And Jesus sent Peter and John.

JESUS: Go and prepare the **Passover** for us, so that we may eat it.
PETER: Where do You want us to prepare it?
JESUS: When you have entered the city, a man will meet you carrying a pitcher of water; follow him into the house that he enters. And you shall say to the owner of the house, 'The Teacher says to you, "Where is the guest room in which I may eat the **Passover** with My disciples?' And he will show you a large, furnished upper room; prepare it there.
NARRATOR: And they left and found *everything* just as He had told them; and they prepared the **Passover**.

Luke 22:14-23
NARRATOR: When the hour had come, He reclined *at the table*, and the apostles with Him.
JESUS: I have earnestly desired to eat this **Passover** with you before I suffer; for I say to you, I shall never

again eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God.

NARRATOR: And when He had taken a cup *and* given thanks, He spoke.

JESUS: Take this and share it among yourselves; for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine from now on until the kingdom of God comes.

NARRATOR: And when He had taken *some* bread *and* given thanks, He broke it and gave it to them and spoke.

JESUS: This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me.

NARRATOR: And in the same way *He took* the cup after they had eaten, and spoke.

JESUS: This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood. But behold, the hand of the one betraying Me is with Mine on the table. For indeed, the Son of Man is going as it has been determined; but woe to that man by whom He is betrayed!

NARRATOR: And they began to discuss among themselves which one of them it might be who was going to do this thing.
