Philippians 2:9-11

<sup>9</sup> For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, <sup>10</sup> so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup> and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Revelation 5:11-14

<sup>11</sup> Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne and the living creatures and the elders; and the number of them was myriads of myriads, and thousands of thousands, <sup>12</sup> saying with a loud voice,  
“Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing.”  
<sup>13</sup> And every created thing which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all things in them, I heard saying,  
“To Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, *be* blessing and honor and glory and dominion forever and ever.”  
<sup>14</sup> And the four living creatures kept saying, “Amen.” And the elders fell down and worshiped.

## THE RESURRECTION

The Gospel according to 1 Corinthians 15:3-4

That Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures

And that He was buried

And that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures.

### 1 CORINTHIANS 15:12-18 [the resurrection of the body]

**Problem:** <sup>12</sup>Now if Christ is preached, that he has been raised from the dead, how do some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?

**Reasoned answer:**

A. <sup>13</sup>But if there is no resurrection of the dead, not even Christ has been raised; **[You can't have a resurrected Christ if there will not be a resurrected you]**

B. <sup>14</sup>and if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is vain (worthless), your faith also is vain (worthless).

**[and if there is no resurrected Christ, our preaching and your faith has absolutely no benefit.]**

X. <sup>15</sup>Moreover we are even found to be false witnesses of God, because we testified (lied) against God that He raised Christ, whom He did not raise, if in fact the dead are not raised. **[If there is not resurrection of the dead, then we have lied against God, by saying that He raised Christ from the dead, when He did not.]**

A. <sup>16</sup>For if the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised; **[You can't have a resurrected Christ if there will not be a resurrected you]**

B. <sup>17</sup>and if Christ has not been raised, your faith is vain, you are still in your sins. **[and if there is no resurrected Christ your faith is worthless (vain) and we are still in our sins/unforgiven].**

<sup>18</sup>Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished **[there is no eternal life].**

**Question: What do the Corinthians believe and what do they not believe?**

## Luke 20:27-40 IN PLAY FORM FOR TEACHING

**NARRATOR:** Now there came to Him some of the Sadducees (who say that there is no resurrection), and they questioned Him.

**SADDUCEES:** Teacher, Moses wrote for us that IF A MAN'S BROTHER DIES, having a wife, AND HE IS CHILDLESS, HIS BROTHER SHOULD MARRY THE WIFE AND RAISE UP CHILDREN TO HIS BROTHER. Now there were seven brothers; and the first took a wife and died childless; and the second and the third married her; and in the same way all seven died, leaving no children. Finally the woman died also. In the resurrection therefore, which one's wife will she be? For all seven had married her.

**JESUS:** The sons of this age marry and are given in marriage, but those who are considered worthy to attain to that age and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry nor are given in marriage; for they cannot even die anymore, because they are like angels, and are sons of God, being sons of the resurrection.

**Question: What is the difference between "this age" and "that age?"**

But that the dead are raised, even Moses showed, in the *passage about the burning bush*, where he calls the Lord THE GOD OF ABRAHAM, AND THE GOD OF ISAAC, AND THE GOD OF JACOB. Now He is not the God of the dead but of the living; for all live to Him.
